SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS FOR ADMISSION

Application forms can be obtained from the College office and the filled-in-forms should be submitted on or before the date announced. Separate application form has to be submitted for each group of combinations.

The following certificates have to be produced in Original along with a set of Xerox copies.

- Memorandum of marks of SSC or its equivalent examination.
- 2. Transfer Certificate
- Bonafide and Conduct Certificate
- Migration Certificate (in the case of students belonging to any other state)
- Caste/Community Certificate and income Certificate for reserved category.



SELECTION OF THE CANDIDATES

The candidates will be selected on the basis of merit. The reservation rules of the Government are followed.

PAYMENT OF FEES

College fees can be paid in two installments in an academic year.

I term - June

II term - September

The selected candidates have to pay fees in State Bank of India, Barkatpura Branch through Challan.

No cheques will be accepted.

THE FEES ONCE PAID IS NEITHER REFUNDABLE NOR TRANSFERABLE

Fee challan should be submitted in the college office immediately after payment of the fees and the student copy should be retained till the end of the course.

ACADEMIC ASSESSMENT

A student's academic progress is assessed through regular classes, unit tests, terminal and pre-final examinations.

Attendance for these tests is compulsory.

Records of the students' performance are maintained and marks sheets will be sent to the parents through SMS.

A parent teacher meeting will be held twice a year.

Change of address or phone number should be communicated in writing to the concerned lecturer and the office.



DISCIPLINE

- 1. The College functions from 9.00 A.M. to 3.00 P.M. Students should always carry their identity cards.
- 2. Students should be present in the college by 8.45 A.M. Gates will be closed at 8.50 A.M. sharp.
- Attendance is taken in every period. The students should put in minimum 75% attendance in all the subjects.
- 4. Parents will be informed about the shortage of attendance through SMS, marks sheet and by telephone. The parents should meet the principal immediately on receipt of such message.
- Students absent from college should submit a leave letter signed by the parent to the concerned lecturer duly attested by the principal. Submission of leave letters is only for granting leave and not for attendance.
- Continuous absence of a student without the permission of the principal will result in her dismissal and subsequently the name will be removed from the rolls.
- Students will not be allowed to leave the college during the college hours, including the lunch hour, for any purpose.

- Proper discipline must be maintained in and out of the class rooms and indiscipline of any sort will be dealt with seriously.
